

About Camp Heritage

Camp Heritage is located on the Lake of the Ozarks in central Missouri near the town of Climax Springs. Camp Heritage is a Christian camp, operated by the lowa-Missouri Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. Registrations are accepted from boys and girls ages 7-17 (18 for DiscipleTrek).

Camp Fees

Fees include lodging, meals, activities, and secondary accident insurance.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Iowa Transportation

A shuttle operates between Camp Heritage and Des Moines, IA. Our shuttle loads at the Des Moines Adventist Church (2317 Watrous Ave, Des Moines, IA 50321) on Tuesday morning at 7:00 AM and returns on Sunday afternoon at 12:30 PM. Fares are \$40 each way (\$80 round trip). Space is limited so reservations are required. Other pick-up/drop-off locations along the Hwy 65 or I-35/Hwy 7 corridors may be arranged based on availability.

Activities

Archery, boat rides and tubing, canoeing, ceramics, crafts, fishing, group games, horsemanship, kneeboarding, model rocketry, nature, outdoor survival, recreational basketball, rock climbing/ rappelling, swimming, wake boarding, wake surfing, and water skiing are among the activities we offer. The earlier you register, the more likely you will get your first choice!

Attending Multiple Weeks

As long as it is age appropriate, after April 15 at noon we will allow campers to register for multiple weeks of camp. Camp Heritage will not be able to provide supervision of campers between weeks of camp. Parents, or their designees, will need to collect campers and their belongings on Sunday morning and then return them on Tuesday for their new week of camp.

Accommodations

Campers share a cabin with up to seven other campers (five for Cub Camp) and a counselor. Cabins are carpeted and have air conditioning. A bathhouse with bathrooms and showers is located nearby.

Food

Your camper will enjoy three healthy, kid-friendly, vegetarian (meatless) meals each day. Special requests for allergies/ intolerances may be accommodated.
